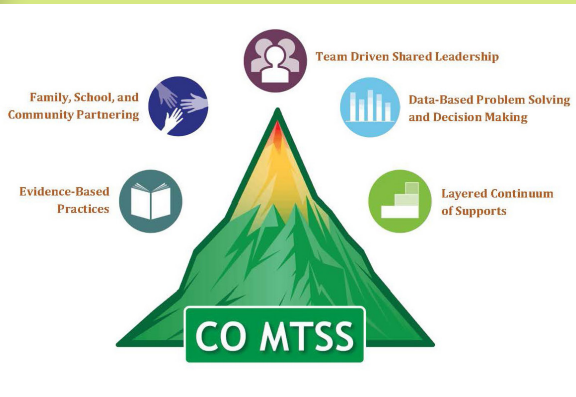

How MTSS Serves Students and Schools

Support for all components of an articulated MTSS framework in PSD Schools

- ✳ Teaming structures
- ✳ Problem-solving process
- ✳ Layered supports
- ✳ Research and evidence-based practices
- ✳ Universal screening and progress monitoring
- ✳ Active family partners
- ✳ Ongoing professional learning opportunities

Menu of services:

- Support development and implementation of effective MTSS practices
- Regularly attend building MTSS team meetings
- Partner with teams to identify needs and outcomes at all intervention levels
- Assist in developing action plans
- Provide consultation regarding MTSS systems and best practices
- Collaborate with team(s) to bring relevant district MTSS information to all school staff
- Answer questions about MTSS and provide examples of how others are implementing framework
- Provide school team(s) with MTSS presentations and workshops customized to specific needs
- Facilitate visitations for school staff to see MTSS framework in other schools/ districts



- Provide tools to help focus efforts and evaluate progress
- Work with team(s) to interpret and use data to inform decisions
- Promote collaboration and events between schools and department throughout the district
- Celebrate all the great work!

- Connect team(s) and school staff to school-training and district-wide professional development
- Model examples of a variety of strategies and implementation ideas
- Provide sample protocols, flow charts, problem solving sheets, action plans, etc
- Provide ideas for family involvement
