



Khan Academy Parent Guide


1. Go to www.khanacademy.org.
2. Click sign-in up at the top right.



3. Sign in using your student's PSD email and login.



4. To look at your student's activity/minutes, select the Progress Tab, and then Activity.



5. If the assignment is done, it will have a score in the fourth column.
