Current Sports Physical:

- Sports Physicals are required for **All** athletes who want to participate and must be updated annually.
 - **All athletes must have a current sport’s physical before you can participate in any in-season practice or pre-season camp.**
- In addition to your doctor or various health clinics throughout Ft Collins, sports physicals will be offered at the Health and Wellness Center at Centennial High School
 - Starting July- August 2018, the Health and Wellness Center at Centennial High School will be open to any Poudre School District Middle or High School student, including uninsured or underinsured, who need a Sports Physicals/Well Child exam.
 - Students/families can call the center’s main number at **970.488.4950** to schedule an appointment. Although the Center can and does bill insurance if available (including Medicaid and CHP+), **our hope is to meet the needs of students/families that are uninsured or underinsured and/or having a difficult time scheduling this annual exam.** Families will be asked to provide insurance information and if none is available, to self-report income to be put on a sliding scale. The Center does not currently collect any cash copayment/ payment of any type. **No student is ever turned away for inability to pay and all students who enroll in the Center can be seen AT NO COST TO the student/family.**

Athletic Fees:

- **All 6th-8th grade sports carry a \$105 fee per athlete with no family maximum.** (Charter, home school and private school fees are \$157).
